Methods of teaching the normal structure and functioning of female genital tract with Anatomy, Physiology, Embryology & Histology knowledge. How to teach Gynaecological case taking. Demonstrate application of case taking methods & techniques in different clinical situations, in the wards and in the community. Evolving a format of interview evaluation for perfecting the art of the interview. Standardization of case record. Demonstration of general physical examination, recording of vital signs, clinical examination of female genital tract and the interpretation. Analysis and evaluation of the case for repertorization and prescription. Antenatal examination and interpretation. Demonstrating the Clinico-Pathological Correlations and relate the susceptibility to the individual case. Demonstrating the extension of the knowledge of Susceptibility to Therapeutic Planning in managing cases of OBG. Understanding the concept of preventive/community medicine in OBG and implementing it in ANC OPD and counseling a couple on the use of various contraceptive devices.
